Entry Level

Entry level qualifications can help learners to build skills, increase knowledge and boost confidence. They are suitable for a wide range of individuals including learners who may not have yet achieved GCSEs.

Courses Levels 1-3

We have a wide range of courses that are tailored to each individual learner's needs to help each young person achieve their career aspirations, through working in a practical environment mirroring your chosen industry.


Our Level 3 courses are equivalent to UCAS points, giving you the opportunity to use your course as a stepping stone to a degree-level qualification at university.

Apprenticeships

If you choose to do an apprenticeship, as an apprentice you will be employed by a company and earn a wage while you learn, working alongside experienced staff to gain sector specific skills.

You will be supported by College throughout your apprenticeship, with the opportunity to build up experience and knowledge that will help you to work towards achieving a nationally recognised qualification.



Maths and English skills help you in everyday life and will enable you to achieve your aims and ambitions.

If you have not achieved GCSE A*-C/9-4 you will undertake these qualifications alongside your main programme.

Unsure what you want to do?

We have launched a new range of 'Routes to...' Level 1 courses that will offer you the chance to try out a curriculum area to see if it is for you.

These one year vocational programmes will allow you to specialise from Level 2 onwards.

There are no entry requirements, just a keen interest in exploring your chosen subject area.

Alongside your chosen vocational area you will also study English and maths and core units to develop your skills including personal development and employability.


New Courses

Entry Requirements

If you have not achieved maths and English at grade 9-4 you will undertake these qualifications alongside your main programme.

In addition, you need to have:

- A genuine interest in the area you wish to study in
- A good reference

Some courses will require you to have an interview or assessment to ensure you meet the requirements of the course and are put on the right level course.

Some courses may also have additional entry requirements such as work experience which you may have to already have in place before starting your course.

Entry	To be undertaking pre GCSEs.	
Level 1	Completion of a GCSE programme or equivalent.	
Level 2	Four GCSEs at grade 4 and above or a Level 1 qualification in a relevant area.	
Level 3	5 GCSEs at grades 4 and above including English and maths grade 4 or a Level 2 qualification in a relevant area.

- A paper copy can also be requested from college.


3. Attend
