Tuition Fees

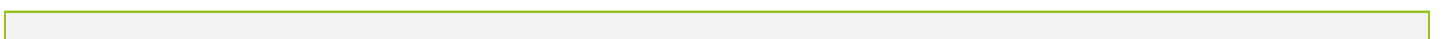
- 16-18 year olds do not need to pay course fees
