As an experienced support worker, you will carry out a range of clinical and non-clinical healthcare or therapeutic tasks mostly under the supervision of the registered healthcare practitioner.

At times you will also be in a role of supporting new staff, students on placement or more junior staff to develop their skills.

You will also study the 15 standards of the Care Certificate and gain a Level 3 Diploma in Healthcare Support. You will have the option to specialise and choose a pathway to suit your job role from:

- Adult Nursing Support
- Theatre Support
- Allied Health Profession – Therapy Support
