Enrichment activities are planned to provide a holistic approach to ensuring you have the opportunity for personal and professional development and develop specific industry skills.

Throughout the programme learners will be supported in filling knowledge gaps using resources on Google classroom, multi-media resources, e-chalk and library resources. Support in English and maths support will be embedded into the unit.

The sequence of the programme will incorporate a range of upskilling workshops preparing learners for the next step wither onto a level IMI programme or entry level employment within an auto repair shop or similar automotive company.

Work experience will focus on social enterprise activities such as valeting services and assisting pre-MOT checks.

Our tutors work as team with learners instead of simply instructing – tailoring their teaching to suit learner needs in fantastic facilities.
