The UAL Level 4 Professional Diploma in Creative Enterprise has been designed to provide you with the skills, knowledge, and understanding necessary to develop your career as a creative professional.

- Relevant Level 3 qualification, e.g. BTEC, UAL, A Level or Access to HE Diploma or relevant apprenticeship
- Approved age of 18+ · Mature students may have commensurate work/business/industry related experience that may be considered
- Pitch us your ideas for a start-up project
- Students should have GCSE grade 4 (or equivalent grade) or above in both English and Maths
