This Performance industries Level 1, is an exciting course for those who are interested in a career in performance-related sectors. This course demonstrates what necessary skills and qualities you need to acquire to begin a successful route through the performing arts sector.

You will discover the world of performing arts and how this area of our society ticks, what jobs are available and how they all work together to make one of the most successful and vibrant industries out there. You will build skills and confidence in basic performance skills such as how to read and perform scripts, handle your body and voice to get the best out of them and to emphasise and explore what is unique about you. There will be opportunities to present your ideas and perform alongside others in your class.

You will also study an appropriate English and Maths qualification and develop transferable employability and communication skills.

What Will I Study?

- How effective 'tableaus' (a group of models or motionless figures) can be in performance, relating to different physical levels onstage and distance between actors
- Stage fighting workshops and Commedia Dell'Arte (Comedy of Craft) training and awareness in delivery

- Study an appropriate English and Maths qualification and develop transferable employability and communication skills.
